

Adding Borders to a Quilt

Measurements should be taken across the center of the quilt in two or three places for both width and length.

To make a border with straight cut corners

1. Determine the length of the quilt border by averaging the two or three center measurements of the quilt body
2. Cut two borders that length and pin them to opposite sides of the quilt. Match the ends and the centers, then gently ease in any fulness
3. Pin, sew and press.
4. Repeat for the top and bottom borders
